
Decorated cars will be parked "drive in" style with drivers inside, snacks and a box juice will be served and a short movie will be shown.

Pilgrims Searched for a Better Life

The next meeting of the United Methodist Men is scheduled for 11:30 a.m. Sunday, March 9 in the Fellowship Hall with lunch made by Dave Fraser. Everyone is invited to hear more about the history of the Mayflower pilgrims from Judy Cunningham and Barbara Matulich, members of the Mayflower Society. The cost for lunch is \$6 per person or \$15 per family.

In 1620, a brave group of 102 men, women, and children sailed across the Atlantic on the Mayflower in search of a better life. The General Society of Mayflower Descendants was established in 1894 to research and educate the public about that crossing. The Society provides education and understanding of why the Mayflower Pilgrims were important, how they shaped western civilization, and what their 1620 voyage means today and its impact on the world.

Since its founding, the Mayflower Society has welcomed over 100,000 members who could prove Mayflower descent and has an ever-growing number of members across the globe.

If mornings are your thing, the UMM is meeting at 7 am each Friday morning for a Prayer Breakfast. Gather in Mary's Kitchen for coffee, pastries, sharing news about those who need prayer, and fellowship. All men are invited to join.
